In Support of Identifying and Tracking Student Veterans

Summary: A resolution in support of an electronic system designed to help various university entities assess the needs of graduate students who are active or veteran members of the military.

Whereas (1): The University of Texas at Austin has shown its solid commitment to serving the student veteran population by creating Student Veteran Services in the Office of the Dean of Students; and

Whereas (2): Student veterans have unique needs compared to the general student body, especially those involving tuition because of federal and state grants; and

Whereas (3): Approximately 37% of veterans returning from Iraq and Afghanistan deal with mental health issues¹; and

Whereas (4): The University of Texas currently does not have a system that identifies and tracks veterans electronically; and

Whereas (5): Identifying and tracking student veterans allows Student Veteran Services and other student services to better serve the on campus needs of the student veteran population

Therefore

Let it be

Resolved (1): That the Graduate Student Assembly supports the creation of an electronic auditing system that identifies student veterans, monitors their academic progress, verifies enrollment and completion of courses that count toward their degree, provides guidance in understanding and using the information, provide information about mental health services from the Counseling and Mental Health Center (CMHC) and services for students with disabilities (SSD), and gives the student access to this information via the internet²; and
