8	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT	That Title III Ch3.02 be deleted; and,
9	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT	That Title III Ch3.05 read "A list of all candidates for office will be made available online, by the Graduate Student Assembly, after filing has closed."; and,
11 12	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT	That Title III Ch4A.01 refer to the spending limit of Executive Alliances instead of Presidential and Vice-Presidential Candidates.; and,
